_____ (initials) I understand that I will pay a grooming fee for the base services I have requested for my pet and I will incur additional fees for any of the above ancillary services that I have requested. I further understand that if I do not pick up my pet by the close of business, I will incur boarding rates per the standard rate sheet. I understand that if my pet is extremely matted, he/she may require a shave.

_____ (initials) Matted coats and excessive undercoats cause a variety of health problems for your pet. Matted fur does not allow for ir circulation to the skin, causing hot spots, bacterial and fungal infections. Fleas, ticks, and other parasites may be lurking in the coat causing further skin infections. Matted fur also pulls and binds causing pain to your pet when they move or lay on their mats. The skin underneath can be raw and inflamed. I understand that if my pet is extremely matted, he/she may require a shave and that a shaving or mat removal may result in nicks or minor injuries.

_____ (initials) There is a chance that your pet's skin will become irritated, more irritated, or injured during bathing, drying, brushing, clipping, scissoring, and stripping process. He or she may be nicked or cut while having to work closely to the skin to remove the coat. We take every precaution to avoid injury, but there is always a possibility of minor to severe injury.

_____ (initials) Nail trimming is included with a full pet grooming service. With nail trimming, your pet's nails may be "quicked" and bleed. A styptic powder will be applied to stop the bleeding, but a nail that has been "quicked" may begin to bleed again once your pet becomes active after the grooming process. Home remedies such as cornstarch or all-purpose flour can control any bleeding that results from a quicked nail after the grooming process.

We recommend that you have your dog groomed every 6 to 8 weeks, would you like for us to make your next appointment today?
